Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes.

- 1. All dogs must <u>be on leash, attached to their Handler or in a crate</u> when not competing in the ring or at the practice jump.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with AKC agility rules and regulations and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- 3. Telegraph, telephone, email, AKC online entries, fax, and unsigned entries will not be accepted.
- 4. A refund of entries minus a service fee of \$15/dog/day for bitches in season (SERVICE FEE) or injured dogs will be granted when a veterinarian's letter is presented as proof to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the 1st trial day dog is entered. Must use official Vet Letter Head.
- 5. Females in season will be refunded a partial refund if withdrawn by the trial secretary after closing and no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The club may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium (no fee paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn). Clubs may determine the documentation if any, that is required confirming the female is in season. Clubs must list this AKC policy along with all other situations for which they will provide a refund. Clubs must treat all occurrences of a listed refund equally.
