DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Move ups must be received by 6pm Monday, May 23, 2022 in writing. **Email is preferred, just reply to confirmation.** Day to day move ups are allowed, on paper, within 30 minutes of end of trial.

RIBBONS, AWARDS AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height division in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Dogs must qualify to receive placement or qualifying ribbons and prizes. New title rosettes and Double Q rosettes will be offered.

Dogs earning their **FIRST** MX, MXJ, MXP and MJP titles will receive a special rosette. Subsequent Masters titles earned at these trials will receive a new title rosette. **Those completing MACHs or PACHs** will receive a special rosette, and MACH or PACH bar. **Those completing PAXs** (Preferred Agility Excellent title) will receive a special Rosette.

PRIZES AND AWARDS – COCKER SPANIELS ONLY

A special logo/breed item will be offered to each owner (or one co-owner) per weekend entering a Cocker Spaniel.

Saturday thru Monday

Special rosettes will be offered for the High Scoring Cocker in each class each day (all heights, Novice, Open, Excellent, Master and all preferred classes).

Two-Day Cocker Champion Awards (Saturday and Sunday)

In order to award excellence in both speed and consistency, the Capital City Cocker Club is supporting "Champion" awards for Cocker Spaniels only for each combined Excellent/Master jump height, including preferred, i.e., 16", 12", 8", 12" P, 8"P, 4"P. Winners will receive a special extra-large rosette and special award. Winners will be determined by adding the combined MACH points from the Standard and JWW classes for both Saturday and Sunday, and adding 5 bonus points for a Q in both Standard and JWW on the same day.

There will also be "High Scoring Veteran" and "High Scoring Veteran Preferred" awards. To be eligible, dogs must be at least 9 years old on the day of the trial, and sign up at the trial. Winners will receive a special extra-large rosette and special award. Winners will be determined according to the same calculations as the "Champion" awards above. These two-day awards will be presented after the conclusion of competition on Sunday.

OBSTACLES, COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Retired runs!!!!

Most of us know how hard it is to retire our canine partners and how much we miss the special connection that comes with running them. So, to give those partners one more “run in the sun”, we will be offering a Special run on Sunday in the Jumpers ring immediately after Novice. The course will consist of a few jumps and tunnels and you may do as many or as few as you’d like and at any height.

Only dogs not entered in this year’s trial **are eligible** and were not entered in the VETERNS RUN last year. CCCC will provide each “competitor” with a rosette to celebrate.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From **Baltimore:** From Baltimore Beltway (I-695) take Exit 19, Northwest Expressway(I-795) towards Owings Mills/Reisterstown. Continue until the Expressway ends, bear right onto Route 140 West. Follow 140 West for approx. 10 miles, turn left onto Route 97 (Weis Market on right, PetSmart on the left.) At the 2nd light, turn Left onto Old Westminster Pike. The Carroll Indoor Sports Center will be on the right a short distance after the turn.

From **DC & Virginia:** From DC Beltway (I-495) take I-270 exit towards Frederick. From 270, take Damascus exit (Route 27 North). Stay on 27 North approx. 25 miles to Main Street in Westminster. Turn right onto Main Street. Go 1.5 miles. C.I.S.C. will be on right side of road after crossing over Route 97.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

First Received - Entries accepted on a first received basis with preference for Cocker Spaniels. From Monday March 1, 2022 until Monday March 15, 2022 entries of Cocker Spaniels will be accepted first. Entries for all other breeds will also be accepted starting on Tuesday March 16 and will be kept in order of receipt - but will not be processed until after March 15, 2022. Preliminary confirmations for breeds other than Cocker Spaniels will be sent out after March 15, 2022.

A WAIT LIST: CCCC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **20 entries per trial** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary on or before **May 13, 2022**. Checks for entry fees will not be deposited until the closing date. Checks for entries that are not accepted in the trials will be shredded.

Delivery Options – Entries received in the first 24 hrs. after the opening date and time must be mailed/delivered to the Trial Secretary. No hand carries will be accepted during this period. Express mail envelopes must have a signature waiver. If these conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

Puppies under 4 months of age are strictly prohibited from the grounds.

All dogs must be on a leash attached to their handler **at all times on the grounds** except when in the ring, when in the designated agility warm-up area, when crated, or when in a secure ex-pen.

NO FLEXI LEADS ARE ALLOWED INDOORS.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that **exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children**. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund will be made of any entry fees paid.

Refunds after closing: Refunds (all but \$5 per run of the entry fees/day) will be made for injured dogs/handlers or handlers contracting Covid 19 and/or in a quarantine period due to exposure for same.

Bitches in Season all but \$5 per day (processing fee). The Trial Secretary must be notified of **all** refund requests **in writing** (present any supporting documents if asked) as early as possible after the closing of entries, and no later than noon on the trial date.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
