

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course <u>without a dog</u> prior to the start of the class, following the judge's briefing. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class.

A warm-up area consisting of a regulation jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may NOT use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

Move-ups

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition; however, written notice (mail or email) MUST be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 6 p.m. the Monday BEFORE the trial. No verbal changes will be accepted. Day-to-day move-ups are always accepted at back-to-back trials where Scores N More is the Trial Secretary. IMPORTANT EVENT INFO RELATED TO COVID-19 RULES

- 1. Submit your signed COVID-19 waiver to the trial secretary prior to the trial. Every person entering the facility for our trial must submit a waiver.
- 2. The Nittany Valley Sports Centre is large enough that we anticipate room for all dogs to be crated inside the air-conditioned facility if desired and for handlers to sit inside with their dogs while maintaining social distancing, as needed.
- 3. Because pandemic conditions and state rules change frequently, we will wait until just before closing to issue final safety precautions. That will give all exhibitors time to withdraw their entries if they do not feel comfortable with these precautions. Our trial will comply with all governmental and facility rules. At this time, we anticipate at least the following:
